Romans 12:10-12 10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; 11 not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; 12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;

Prayer is vital for us as we go forward in the New Year, and the South Yadkin Baptist Association is continuing to emphasize prayer in the upcoming year.

We have much to be in prayer for - our country is in a mess, and Covid has affected our families and our churches. We need to seek God for wisdom and discernment. There is a lost and dying world all around us that needs a Savior.

The Baptist Convention of North Carolina is urging NC Baptists to unite in prayer toward unreached people across our state. They have identified 250 Pockets of Lostness here in North Carolina - areas where a high concentration of unchurched and unsaved people live. Eight pockets of lostness are found right here in the South Yadkin Baptist Association. But before we can truly impact this lostness, we need to bathe it in prayer.

To coordinate our association's efforts, we have divided our SYBA area into three geographic areas (like we do our Pastors Area Prayer Meetings which will resume in February - see note below). Toy Store for Jesus looked a little different this year, but our impact was tremendous!

To address Covid-19 pandemic concerns, we used a drive-thru format with pre-filled bags of toys and other items for families. Wish-list items were provided by the parents on their recommendation forms (prior to the event), and we honored these as much as possible. This idea worked wonderfully for a number of reasons - children received their most desired toys, the lines of cars in the drive-thru moved smoothly, and we were able to use our *Toy Store for Jesus* donated funds to purchase specific toys requested by families.

Social distancing and masks were required of our invited guests and SYBA volunteers. Encouragers offered every guest prayer, a Bible, and conversation about their relationship with Christ. In addition, each guest was encouraged to watch a video explaining more about God's Story ([click here to check it out](#)). Guests who watched the video were entered into a drawing to receive a food gift card for their family.
